What you'll need for your course

Congratulations on being offered a place! To get the best out of your course, it helps to ensure all your work is organised and that you have the resources you will require. We strongly recommend that you purchase the following:

- Pen, coloured pens, pencil, ruler, eraser, highlighter and sharpener
- Notebook or small sketchbook
- · Basic drawing equipment
- Laptop or another internet enabled device (this is not essential, however it is recommended)
- Level 2 Photography & Film students will also require their own DSLR or similar digital camera
