Summer preparation

Before you start your course, we recommend you attend as many performances over the summer as you can, this could be a music event or stage production. We have some fantastic venues within Cumbria and Lancashire, such as Brewery Arts, Theatre by The Lake, The Sands Centre, The Forum, The Dukes & The Grand which you can visit.

What you'll need for your course

To get the best out of your course, it helps to ensure you have the resources you will require. We strongly recommend that you purchase the following:

- Scale ruler (including 1:1, 1:20, 1:25, 1:50)
- Scale lantern stencil (1:25)
- Steel-toe-capped boots (Black)
- Black trousers and t-shirt
- Laptop or other internet enabled device (this is not essential however it is recommended)
