


To help you prepare for your study programme we recommend that you acquire the following items:

- Subject textbooks AQA for A-Levels, except Criminology which is WJEC.
- Stationery pens, calculator, ruler, notepaper and
 3-4 lever arch files with dividers (one for each subject).
- 3. Laptop/access to the internet although these are not essential as there are resources available in college, you will be required to undertake study at home, and helpful information for each programme will be available via each subject's virtual learning environment (online).

Enrichment opportunities
